## Luas Cross City Staying Informed

Déanfaimid ár gcroídhícheall a laghad cur isteach agus is féidir a dhéanamh an fhaid is a bheimid ag déanamh dul chun cinn chun fáiltiú ar bord roimh na paisinéirí tosaigh. Tá go leor bealaí ann le bheith ar an eolas agus chun fanacht ar an eolas – ní gá ach Cliogáil, Like nó Follow.

Nascfaidh an síneadh seo leis an Líne Ghlas ceantair shiopadóireachta agus ghnó le seirbhísí rialta ó stadanna áisiúla lárnacha ó Fhaiche Stiabhna go Sráid Pharnell. Freastalóidh an líne chomh maith ar na mílte mac léinn a bheidh ag triall ar Champas nua Institiúid Teicneolaíochta Bhaile Átha Cliath ag Gráinseach Ghormáin agus ar na pobail seanbhunaithe i mBaile Phib agus sa Chabhrach. Tá líonra ardchaighdeán Luas a cheanglóidh seirbhísí na bpríomhlínte traenach uile agus na céadta seirbhísí bus ar amharc anois. Tá na figiúirí suntasach – 10 milliún paisinéirí breise, 800 post le linn tréimhse na tógála agus gan ach 24 nóiméad ón “bhFaiche” go dtí Droichead Broome nuair a thosóidh na tramanna tosaigh ag rith i 2017.
