Terms and Conditions for “The Journey’s on us” (Please read carefully)

1. To enter, submit a completed application form to “Journeys with theJournal.ie”, Corporate Communications, Iarnród Éireann, Connolly Station, Dublin 1, via the online form at www.irishrail.ie/journeys or by email at journeys@irishrail.ie.
2. Only one application per organisation is permitted. Applications submitted by email, online form or by post will be accepted. The closing date for receipt of completed application forms is Monday, 21st October, 2016.
3. It is not necessary to submit any supporting material with the application form, any such material will not be returned and Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail does not accept any responsibility for any lost or damaged applications.
4. Applications will only be accepted from charity, not for profit organisations, sporting groups and other voluntary groups based in the Republic of Ireland.
5. Applicants must be 18 years of age or over but members of the group travelling can be under 18 years of age.
6. The application must have the full support of the applicant organisation and any other support or partnership organisations involved.
7. Successful applicants will be notified by Iarnród Éireann “Journeys with TheJournal.ie” from Friday 11th November, 2016 onwards. The tickets awarded are for the use of the organisation only, are non-transferable or cannot be resold. The maximum number of railway journeys being awarded per group is 50, but they must travel together.
8. Successful applicants will be in a position to avail of a group ticket for up to 50 people travelling together on an agreed return trip which can be used up to the end of November, 2017. Every effort will be made to accommodate the journey request but travel may be restricted on busy services.
9. Applicants agree to participate, without payment, in such publicity relating to the promotion of the Iarnród Éireann “Journeys with theJournal.ie” programme 2016 as Iarnród Éireann may reasonably require. Iarnród Éireann may use any information provided on the application form or in subsequent related correspondence for the purpose of such publicity/promotion, personal data is excluded from this. Successful applicants further agree to formally acknowledge the contribution made by Iarnród Éireann to the applicants’ cause in respect of which the organisations have applied.
10. Any publicity arising from the awards will associate organisations with the cause in respect of which the organisations have applied.
11. The operation of the Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail “Journeys with theJournal.ie” programme 2016, including the level, number and timing of any awards, whether in the form of funds or otherwise, is a matter solely for Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail. The decision of the judge(s) is final and binding on applicants. No correspondence will be entered into.
12. No alternative award (including a cash alternative for a non-cash award) will be offered.
13. Notwithstanding that an applicant has been notified as being successful, if Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail discovers before the distribution of the award that for any reason under these terms and conditions that an applicant should have been ineligible to enter the Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail “Journeys with theJournal.ie” programme 2016 or if the entry should have been declared invalid, Iarnród Éireann Irish rail reserves the right to determine that the applicant is disqualified.

14. Iarnród Éireann reserves the right to amend, withdraw or terminate the Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail “Journeys with theJournal.ie” programme 2016 at any time without prior notice.

15. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail shall not be liable for any loss, damage or injury arising from the Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail “Journeys with theJournal.ie” programme 2016.

16. Iarnród Éireann reserve the right to cancel, terminate, vary, modify or amend the rules of “Journeys with theJournal.ie” programme 2016. All rail journeys taken by passengers must comply with Iarnród Éireann’s rules and regulations concerning passenger rail travel and in particular with CIE’s Bye Laws (S.I. 109/1984).
