

NEVER CROSS THE RAILWAY LINE WHEN THE INDICATOR LIGHT IS RED

In the event of a fault (i.e. where no red or orange indication light shows or where no audio warning tone sounds), before crossing over the railway line, you must follow the instructions on the red "Live Railway Crossing" sign.

DANGER
LIVE RAILWAY CROSSING
Trains are Quiet and Pass at Speed



- **Stop** clear of railway level crossing
- **Open** both gates before crossing
Cross quickly if no trains approaching.
Never stop on a railway crossing. You must:
- **Stop** behind the black and yellow markers
- **Look** both ways every time you cross
- **Listen** for trains (remove ear protection, turn off music)
- **Shut** all gates after use

You must ring Irish Rail on
Lo Call XXXX XXX XXX
for permission to cross with:

• Slow, low-loading or cumbersome vehicles • Herds of animals
• Vehicles carrying dangerous goods • Or where weather is affecting conditions

A person failing to shut & fasten either gate after using the level crossing is liable to prosecution.

DANGER
LIVE RAILWAY CROSSING
Trains are Quiet and Pass at Speed



Before crossing as a Pedestrian:

- **Stop** clear of the railway level crossing
- **Look** both ways for approach of trains
- **Listen** for horn or sound of trains
Keep hold of children or pets.
Turn off any distracting sounds or music.

Cross Quickly if no trains approaching.
Never Stop on a railway level crossing and shut any gates after use.

ALWAYS EXPECT A TRAIN



Iarnród Éireann has installed a train detection warning system at this level crossing.

The objective of this system is:

- (i) to provide you with improved information about the approach of trains, and
- (ii) to assist you with your determination of when it is not safe to cross.

Level crossing gates will remain in position and must be operated in compliance with current arrangements.

This system is not intended to assist level crossing users with movements of slow, heavy, low slung and cumbersome vehicles or herds of animals across the railway line.

You should continue to make special arrangements with Iarnród Éireann for such movements.

Train Detection Warning System in use at this crossing.
In the event that the system is faulty please report the fault to the Lo Call number on the red sign

ORANGE
Cross With
Caution

NEVER cross the railway line when the indicator light is RED

1. Open first gate ensuring it is safe to do so.
2. If display is **RED**, **DO NOT CROSS**
3. If display is **ORANGE**, open second set of gates. **DO NOT CROSS** if light has changed to **RED**
4. **ALWAYS** close both gates after you. Check a train is not approaching.
