IARRATAS Ó CHÓRAS IOMPAIR ÉIREANN AR ORDÚ IARNRÓID

Cuirfidh Córas Iompair Éireann (CIÉ) trí na cumhachtaí a thugtar dó le halt 37 d'acht Iompair (Bonneagar Iarnróid) 2001 (arna leasú agus arna ionadú) iarratas chuig An Bord Pleanála ar nó i ndiaidh an 14 Bealtaine 2021 le haghaidh Ordú Iarnróid de bhun fhorálacha an Achte sin. Údaróidh an tOrdú Iarnróid, má thugtar é, Córas Iompair Éireann chun oibreacha iarnróid agus na hoibreacha ar fad atá riachtanach a dhéanamh chun cur ar chumas CIÉ deireadh a chur le agus, más cuí, seacht gcrosaire comhréidhe uimhrithe a uasghrádú agus na hoibreacha gaolmhara agus coimhdeacha ar fad a chur i gcrích feadh stráice 24 ciliméadar de Líne Iarnróid Bhaile Átha Cliath go Corcaigh mar seo a leanas:

- XC187 – Baile an Fhóntaigh – An crosaire comhréidh atá ann a dhúnadh: An trácht a chur ar mhalaírt slí feadh bóithre atá ann chuig tardhroichead thart ar 3 chiliméadar i dtreo an oirthuaiscirt;
- XC 201 – Baile Thomáis – An crosaire comhréidh atá ann a dhúnadh. Droichead nua bóthar-os-cionn-droichid. Nascadh leis an mbóthar áitiúil atá ann ó dheas agus le hacomhal nua ar an mbóthar Réigiúnach, R515, ó thuaidh;
- XC209 – Bealach Átha – An crosaire comhréidh atá ann a uasghrádú chuig crosaire comhréidh 4-bhacainn arna rialú ag CCTV;
- XC211 – An Baile Nua – An crosaire comhréidh atá ann a dhúnadh. Bóthar rochtana nua díreach taobh thoir den bhóthar-os-cionn-droichid atá ann ó thuaidh de XC211 - An Baile Nua, chun nascadh leis an mbóthar áitiúil atá ann ar an taobh thoir de XC211 - An Baile Nua;
- XC212 – Baile Uí Choscraigh (Sráidbhaile Bhealach Átha) – An crosaire comhréidh atá ann a dhúnadh Droichead nua bóthar-os-cionn-droichid le nascadh leis an mbóthar áitiúil atá ann ag na taobh thoir agus thiar den chrosaire comhréidh, carrchlós nua leis an scoil atá ann. Le nascadh le hEastát Choill na Fea agus Scoil Náisiúnta Bhealach Átha ó thuaidh agus leis an mbóthar áitiúil atá ann ó dheas;
- XC215 – Seangánach – An crosaire comhréidh atá ann a dhúnadh Bóthar rochtana nua le nascadh leis an mbóthar-os-cionn-droichid atá thart ar 1km i dtreo an tuaiscirt; agus
- XC219 – Cill na Mallach – An crosaire comhréidh atá ann a dhúnadh. Droichead nua bóthar-os-cionn-droichid a thógáil le nascadh leis an mbóthar réigiúnach atá ann i dtreo an oirthir agus an iarthair.

AN BORD PLEANÁLA

TRANSPORT (RAILWAY INFRASTRUCTURE) ACT 2001

(AS AMENDED AND SUBSTITUTED)

APPLICATION BY CÓRAS IOMPAIR ÉIREANN FOR A RAILWAY ORDER

Córas Iompair Éireann (CIÉ) in exercise of its powers conferred upon it by section 37 of the Transport (Railway Infrastructure) Act 2001 (as amended and substituted) will apply on or after the 14th May 2021 to An Bord Pleanála for a Railway Order pursuant to the provisions of the said Act.

The Railway Order, if granted, will authorise Córas Iompair Éireann to carry out railway works and all works necessary to enable CIÉ to eliminate and, where necessary, upgrade seven numbered level crossings and carry out all associated and ancillary works along a 24 kilometre section of the Dublin to Cork Railway Line as follows:

- XC187 - Fantstown - Closure of existing level crossing: Divert traffic along existing roads to existing overbridge approximately 3 kilometres to the north east;
- XC 201 - Thomastown - Closure of existing level crossing. New road-over-rail bridge. Tie into existing local road to south and new junction on Regional Road R515 to north;
- XC209 - Ballyhay - Upgrade existing level crossing to a 4-barrier CCTV controlled level crossing;
- XC211 - Newtown - Closure of existing level crossing. New access road immediately east of the existing road-over-rail bridge to the north of XC211 Newton, tie in to existing local road to the east of XC211 Newtown;
- XC212 - Ballycoskery (Ballyhea Village) - Closure of existing level crossing. New road-over-rail bridge to tie into existing local road to east and west of level crossing, new car park to existing school. Tie into Beechwood Estate and Ballyhea National School to north and existing local road to south;
- XC215 - Shinanagh - Closure of existing level crossing. New access road to tie into existing road-over-rail bridge approximately 1km to the north; and
- XC219 - Buttevant - Closure of existing level crossing. Construction of a new road-over-rail bridge and tie in to existing regional road to east and west.

The application will be accompanied by documents including the following:

- A draft of the proposed Railway Order entitled the "Dublin to Cork Railway Line (Elimination and Upgrade) of Level Crossings between Limerick Junction and Mallow Order 2021";
- Plans of the proposed railway works;
- A book of reference to the plan (indicating the identity of the owners and of the occupiers of the lands described in the plan);
- A statement of the likely effects on the environment (an "Environmental Impact Assessment Report") of the proposed railway works;
- A Natura Impact Statement.

Written Submissions

An Bord Pleanála will consider any submissions in relation to the proposed Railway Order or in relation to the likely effects on the environment and the likely significant effects in the area concerned on European Sites, if any, of the proposed railway works which are submitted in writing to it by any person and accompanied by a fee of 50 (This fee is not payable by certain prescribed bodies or by persons whose lands may be acquired under the order). Submissions must be lodged no later than 5.30 p.m. on the 9th July 2021 and must be addressed to An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1 and marked **"Dublin to Cork Railway Line (Elimination and Upgrade) of Level Crossings between Limerick Junction and Mallow Order 2021"**

Oral Hearing

An Bord Pleanála may at its absolute discretion hold an oral hearing into the application for a Railway Order.

Judicial Review

A person may question the validity of any such decision by An Bord Pleanála may make by way of an application for judicial review in accordance with section 47 and 47A of the Transport (Railway Infrastructure) Act 2001 (as amended and substituted) and under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986 as amended) and practical information on the review mechanism can be accessed under the heading 'Publications - Judicial Review Notice' on the Board's website www.pleanala.ie or on the Citizen's Information website www.citizensinformation.ie
