Request:

I would like to obtain details about any road work done in the Salthill /Monkstown Dart station parking lot over the past 3 years.

Response

The car park area in front of Salthill & Monkstown Station is under a long term lease granted from CIE Property to Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council. This lease is full repair & maintenance by Council with right of access retained to Irish Rail station. Iarnród Éireann has no records of works being done in this car park post 2012, and as such feel that this request would be better answered by Dun Laoghaire Rathdown Co. Co.

Rights of appeal

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
