**Re: FOI Request Response [IE\_FOI\_221]**

I refer to your letter request dated 29<sup>th</sup> January 2019 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received on that date, for records held by Iarnród Éireann.

**Request:**

The amount of cars clamped by Apcoa on Irish Rail operated land in each of their stations nationwide for the years 2018, 2017 and 2016 and the amount accrued for Irish Rail from the contract in each year, in tabular form.

I, Sheldon Norton, have now made a final decision to part grant your request on 01<sup>st</sup> March 2019.

You have sought access to the records as listed above and I consider this an appropriate form of access in this case. Accordingly, a copy of the records is now attached including a copy of the schedule to these records. You will note that the 2018 clamping figures for APCOA from when they started the contract in February 2018. Prior to this NCPS were our car parking contractor for 2016 and 2017 and part of 2018, but this information did not form part of the original request.

**Rights of appeal**

You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification, where a day is defined as a working day excluding, the weekend and public holidays, however, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
