Request for Fees - IE_FOI_252

Dear [Redacted],

I refer to your request dated 09th May 2019 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received on that date, for records held by Iarnród Éireann.

Request:

- Details of all reported antisocial behaviour on Irish Rail services in 2018 and 2019, up to May 9, including breakdown by route.
- Details of Irish Rail actions/responses to these incidents.
- Correspondence between Irish Rail management/board and NTA management/board regarding antisocial behaviour policies/procedures, including emails, memos and minutes of meetings.

I am now writing to you to advise you of the costs of your request. The Act allows for the charging of search, retrieval and copying of records which are within the scope of your request, from within this body as set out in Section 27(2) and (3) - <http://www.irishstatutebook.ie/eli/2014/act/30/section/27/enacted/en/html>

After careful consideration and consultations, I estimate that the services of staff will be required for 358 hours, and this will be the minimum amount of time required to efficiently complete the 'search and retrieval and copying' work on your request. The prescribed amount chargeable for each such hour is €20.00 resulting in an overall fee of €7,160.00 (See table below)

You should state that you are seeking this review because an initial decision was not sent to you within the time allowed for a response. You have 4 weeks (after the initial decision should have been sent to you) in which to make the appeal. Consideration will be given to late applications in appropriate circumstances.
