I refer to your request dated 31st August 2019 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received by my office on 2nd September for records held by Iarnród Éireann.

Reponse:

- How many FPN appeals are rejected in an average year?
Number of appeal rejected in an average year is 3,144
- How many appeals are made in an average year?
Number of appeals made in an average year is 3,965
