I refer to your request dated 19th December 2019 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received by my office on that date, for records held by Iarnród Éireann.

Request:

- I am looking for the figures for the amount of toilet cleaning staff employed to clean toilets on the Connolly-Sligo service in the last year

Response:

Toilet cleaning is carried out as part of the overall clean in both Connolly and Sligo where between them they have 17 staff each night. These staff would also clean all other services out of Connolly.
On top of that we have turnaround cleaners in Sligo and Connolly who would clean at the end of each service. 3 staff per day.

I, [REDACTED], have now made a final decision to grant your request on 20th December 2019

Rights of appeal

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
