I refer to your request dated 16th February 2022 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received on by my office on that date, for records held by Iarnród Éireann.

Request:

- 1) The amount of revenue Iarnród Éireann received from the advertisement boards in each of the DART carriages in 2021 and to-date in 2022 in tabular form
- 2) The rates Iarnród Éireann charge for each advertisement board on the DART carriages eg X amount plus VAT at 13.5% per board per month to advertise their product


Rights of appeal

You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification, where a day is defined as a working day excluding, the weekend and public holidays, however, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
