I refer to your request dated 26th April 2020 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received by my office on that date, for records held by Iarnród Éireann.

Request:

Information detailing option(s) for additional spare carriages in the contract made with CAF in 2002? If so, what were the options and how many carriages in total could have been purchased had IÉ taken them up?

Response:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, an individual can request:

- any records relating to them personally, regardless of when they were created
- All other records created after 21st April 2008

As this request precedes the 21st April 2008, I Ms Sue Stanley have now made a final decision to refuse your request on 27th April 2020.

You should make this appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification, were a day is defined as a working day excluding, the weekend and public holidays, however, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
