I refer to your request dated 05th May 2021 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received on by my office on that date, for records held by Iarnród Éireann.

Request:

A full list/inventory of items recovered from trains that were either lost or forgotten by passengers between January, 1, 2020 and January, 1, 2021 in Roscommon. This list should include, if possible, the dates on which they were found and the services in which they were found on in Roscommon. I would prefer to receive this information electronically, ideally in its original electronic format. If you need to clarify anything in this request, please contact me via email

Response:

The trains are only in Roscommon for 1 to 2 minutes while passing through so there would be no lost or found items as no trains would be cleaned there.

In the event that you are not happy with this decision you can make an appeal in relation to this matter, you can do so by writing to the FOI Unit, Corporate Communications, Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail, Connolly Station, Amiens St, Dublin 1 or by e-mail to foi@irishrail.ie. You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification, where a day is defined as a working day excluding, the weekend and public holidays, however, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
