**Response:**

I, Karl Sutton, Decision Maker have now made a final decision to refuse your request on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2022. Under S15(1)(A), a request may be refused if the records sought do not exist.

Please find further detail to your request below:

notifications had been sent out to this area seeking to start a consultation process about the potential removing of an overgrown hedge. This proposed work has now been terminated and the SE&T staff had the hedge trimmed back instead. Therefore, no reports have been carried out.

Regarding your query: *'I understand from your Infrastructure department that it is intended to clean up the area immediately adjacent to the Dart station boundary wall located within Holyrood Park. It would be helpful if this could be clarified and confirmed'.*

Please note, an on-site meeting with the station master Pearse & residents is now being arranged for potentially next Tuesday, all residents will be contacted regarding this meeting.

**Rights of appeal**

You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification, where a day is defined as a working day excluding the weekend and public holidays, however, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
