Dear [REDACTED],

I refer to your request dated 07th October 2020 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received on that date, for records held by Iarnród Éireann.

Request:

I would like records of or correspondence with South West Pallets, Michael O'Regan, Bawnboy, Cloghcrbrien, Tralee, County Kerry.

I am interested in particular in documents pertaining to the Tralee & Fenit Railway and

- ownership of the line and/or adjacent buildings
- illegal trespass and/or construction on the line
- rights of way on the line
- planning permission along the line
- records of the last inspection of the line

What are the different departments in which such information would be kept?

I am now writing to you to advise you of the costs of your request. The Act allows for the charging of search, retrieval and copying of records which are within the scope of your request, from within this body as set out in Section 27(2) and (3) -

After careful consideration and consultations, I estimate that the services of staff will be required for 10 hours, and this will be the minimum amount of time required to efficiently complete the 'search and retrieval and copying' work on your request. The prescribed amount chargeable for each such hour is €20.00 resulting in an overall fee of €200.

In the event that you need to request such a review, you can do so by writing to FOI Unit, Corporate Communications, Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail, Connolly Station, Amiens St, Dublin 1 or alternatively by sending an e-mail to foi@irishrail.ie. You should state that you are seeking this review because an initial decision was not sent to you within the time allowed for a response. You have 4 weeks (after the initial decision should have been sent to you) in which to make the appeal. Consideration will be given to late applications in appropriate circumstances.
