I refer to your request dated 12th October 2022 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, which was received on that day seeking records held by Iarnród Éireann.

Request:

- The amount that Iarnród Éireann spent on refurbishment and or maintenance works that were carried out at Kishogue Train station in the years of 2021 and to-date in 2022 in tabular form. Please include a brief description of what works by year e.g., 2022 we upgraded Emergency lighting system in the station, in 2021 we installed a passenger lift within station etc

I, Ollie Tierney, have now made a final decision to refuse your request on 13th September 2022. A request may be refused if the records sought do not exist (section15(1)(a)) Please see below further explanation.

Response:

Please be advised that Kishogue has been closed during the period outlined above. Therefore, no money has been spent on refurbishment or maintenance for this period. However, existing services have been vandalised and, in most cases, de-energised due to asset condition. The existing lifts will not be modernised until a future decision for Kishogue, as well as funding have been approved for the replacement services.


Rights of appeal

In the event that you are not happy with this decision you can make an appeal in relation to this matter, you can do so by writing to the FOI Unit, Corporate Communications, Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail, Connolly Station, Amiens St, Dublin 1 or by e-mail to foi@irishrail.ie. You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification, where a day is defined as a working day excluding, the weekend and public holidays, however, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
