## Details of all security arrangements in place (in Portmarnock Dart Station car park)

- Security in Portmarnock Station Carpark is managed through the use of CCTV cameras which are reviewed if there any incidents reported.
- There are four signs in the Carpark advising Customers that cars are parked at their owners risk.
- Patrols checking for compliance for valid car parking are also conducted on a regular basis.
- Where there are any noticeable incidents of Vandalism, thefts and or attempted thefts, Station Managers and their teams report them immediately to the local Garda and where necessary provide ongoing support until investigations/prosecutions are concluded.

- The Contractor coordinates a response to any cases of vandalism, actual or attempted theft through a number of measures;
  - o Advising the Station Management of the Incident
  - o Completing an incident report
  - reporting incident immediately at local Garda within 24 hours of incident being notified or incident being reported to the Contractor as a precaution in case the incident had not been reported as yet by a Station Manager or his/her staff.
