I refer to your request dated 9th November 2016 and received by this office on that date, which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for records held by this FOI body. Your request sought:

Request –

- Number of passengers who used the extra late night DART services which were put on in December 2015

Decision –

I, Mr. Paul Slowey, Decision Maker have now made a final decision to release this record on the 24th November 2016.

The total figure of passengers late night services for December 2015 was 7692. We do not have the capability to distinguish between late night DART service users and late night commuter service users,

Rights of appeal
