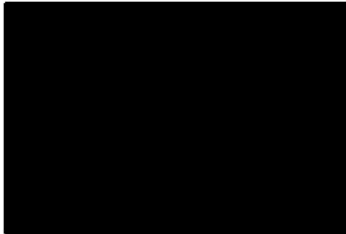

**Re: FOI Request Acknowledgement [IE\_FOI\_083]**

Dear [REDACTED],

I refer to your request dated 8<sup>th</sup> February 2017 and received by this office on the 9<sup>th</sup> February 2017, which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for records held by this FOI body. Your request sought:

**Request –**

1. Records evidencing the overall total cost of the construction of Kishogue Rail Station at Lucan, Co, Dublin including all external roads and carparks;
2. Records evidencing the specific cost of the surfacing of external roads and carparks as part of the construction of Kishogue Rail Station (in the period around 2006-2008);
3. A report on the damage that was done to the surface of external roads and carparks at Kishogue Rail Station due to their use, in 2010, for storage of ballast and/or any other construction and maintenance material to facilitate works to renew pre-existing tracks on the new four track rail section between Inchicore and Hazelhatch; and any assessment/survey carried-out into the costs or other implications of this damage;
4. Records evidencing the costs, since 2008, relating to contracts for the regular maintenance and/or repair of the station building, its lifts, its alarm system and any others elements of the Kishogue Rail Station property;
5. All records, including submissions, reports and internal and external correspondence. Since 2012, relating to proposals to open Kishogue Rail Station to facilitate the stopping of services using the reopened Phoenix Park rail tunnel.

**Decision –**

I, Ms. Sinead Donnelly, Decision Maker have now made a final decision to release this record on the 20th March 2017. Please see attached response pack and appendices.

**Rights of appeal -**

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
