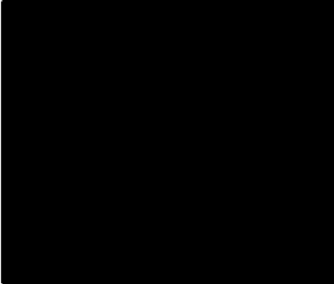

I refer to your email dated 13<sup>th</sup> April 2017 which was received by this office on the 18<sup>th</sup> April 2017 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for records held by this FOI body. Your request sought:

**Request –**

- The total cost to Irish Rail in lost income arising from the stoppage of its services as part of the 'wildcat' strike action earlier this month?
- The number of staff who had their pay reduced as a result of not attending their pace of work as scheduled. I am also seeking the total sum retained by the company in unpaid wages.
- How much on average did each employee lose in unpaid wages?
- All correspondence concerning legal proceedings being taken against the IBRU for losses incurred by Irish Rail as a result of the 'wildcat' strike action. This would include details concerning the amount the company is seeking in compensation.
